PROPOSAL REVIEW

In collaboration with agency partners, we solicit, receive and conduct reviews of proposals from scientists throughout California to establish a portfolio of research to support specific needs.



GRANT ADMINISTRATION

We issue awards to universities, non-profits and businesses, track progress, and evaluate expenditures on awards to assure compliance with federal and state regulations.



FELLOWSHIPS
