Aquaculture supplies more than half of all seafood produced for human consumption, yet the United States' aquaculture industry meets only five to seven percent of domestic seafood demand. The regulatory framework for aquaculture is often cited for stagnating aquaculture growth in the United States. This symposium is an effort to begin the broader discussion about aquaculture law, starting in California with coastal and offshore aquaculture.
